NCWSA Board ...**

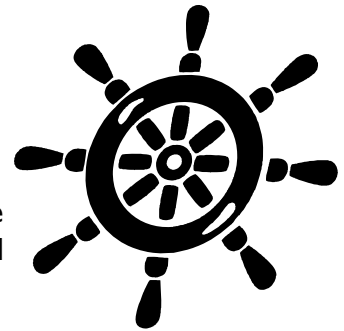

Margo's White Bean Chili:

2 # dried navy beans	2 -4 tsp. black pepper
2 48 oz. cans chicken broth	2 T. dried oregano
2 T. minced garlic	3 T. ground cumin
2 sm. cans chopped green chilies	1 stick butter
2 lbs. skinless, boneless chicken breasts, chopped	1 ½ C. diced onion
About 1 bunch of cilantro, chopped	

Wash beans, cover w/water & soak 2 hrs. Drain. Bring beans & chicken broth to boil in large pot.* In saucepan, heat butter and sauté garlic, onion and chilies about 5 minutes. Add to bean pot. Add chicken, cumin, oregano, pepper, cilantro. Lower heat to medium, cook approx. 2 hrs, stirring. Serve from crock pot with Frito corn scoops. You can also kick it up a notch and add a couple tsp. white pepper (not used in Adams Cup entry)

*I actually refrigerated the cooked beans and broth and finished the dish the next day; then served it a day later at Adams Cup dinner.

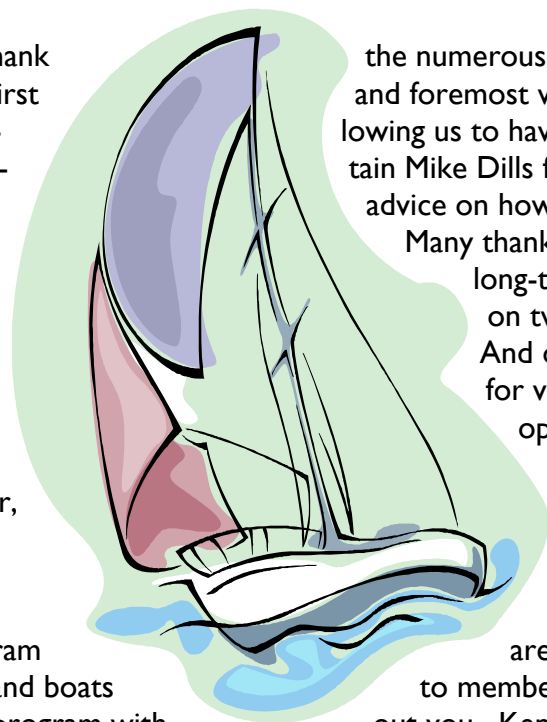
